


Teacher Feedback Analysis Report: Academic Year 2018-2019

Question 1: The Classrooms/Tutorial Rooms have necessary facilities and atmosphere which help in Teaching.

Ratings: 5 (33.3%), 4 (33.3%), 3 (33.3%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (33.3%), 4 (33.3%), 3 (33.3%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (33.3%), 4 (58.3%), 3 (8.3%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (50.0%), 4 (33.3%), 3 (16.7%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (33.3%), 4 (41.7%), 3 (25.0%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (41.7%), 4 (50.0%), 3 (8.3%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (25.0%), 4 (50.0%), 3 (25.0%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (41.7%), 4 (50.0%), 3 (8.3%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Question 11: Suggestions to improve Infrastructure and Ambiance:

- College Vehicle must be changed.
 Analysis: This suggestion indicates dissatisfaction with the current transportation facilities provided by the institute. The need for changing the college vehicle suggests that it might be outdated, unreliable, or not meeting the needs of the faculty. Upgrading or replacing the college vehicle could improve convenience and satisfaction for staff members who rely on this service.
- Provide Lift facility.
 Analysis: The request for a lift facility points to potential accessibility issues within
 the institute's infrastructure. This is particularly important for accommodating faculty,
 staff, and students who may have mobility challenges. Installing a lift would not only
 improve accessibility but also enhance the overall inclusiveness of the institute's
 facilities.

Conclusion:

The feedback for the academic year 2018-2019 reflects an overall positive response from the teachers regarding the infrastructure and ambiance of the institute. The areas of classrooms, library facilities, and ICT support are seen as satisfactory, though there is a clear indication that further improvements could enhance the overall experience. Suggestions such as upgrading the college vehicle and adding a lift facility should be considered to improve the institute's infrastructure.
